- 2. Revised Tentative Order No. R9-2016-0005, General Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges from Commercial Agricultural Operations for Dischargers Not Participating in a Third-Party Group in the San Diego Region (Tentative Individual General Order)
- 3. Revised Tentative Resolution No. R9-2016-0136, Adoption of a Negative Declaration and Initial Study for the General Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges from Agricultural Operations in the San Diego Region (Tentative Negative Declaration)
