

- The following violation has not been noted in previous enforcement actions.
 - Effluent Violation of Discharge Specifications Section IV.C/ SOCWA Jay B. Latham RTP: The instantaneous limitation (3 ml/L) of the effluent concentration of settleable solids (SS) was exceeded during the month of December 2010 with the concentration of 7.5 ml/L. Pursuant to CWC Section 13385(h)(1) a mandatory minimum penalty of three thousand dollars shall be assessed for each "serious violation".

- The San Diego Water Board has the following comments regarding the above reports.
 - 2. Enforcement action for the South Coast Water District Groundwater Recovery Facility has been included in other enforcement actions.
 - 3. At the this time, there is insufficient information to reach a conclusion regarding the contribution, if any, that the discharge is having on the bacteria levels in the near shore. Total coliform, fecal coliform, and/or enterococcus concentrations at a few of the surf zone stations exceeded the receiving water quality standards set forth in Order No. R9-2006-0054, Section V.A.1.
