Messrs. Capati and Frame:

Attached is Investigative Order No. R9-2016-0212, issued pursuant to Water Code section 13267, directing you to submit a technical report no later than December 19, 2016, pertaining to an unauthorized discharge of storm water runoff from the Portola Center South construction site on or about October 24, 2016. Water Code section 13267 allows the California State Water Resources Control Board and the California Regional Water Quality Control Boards to conduct investigations and to require technical and monitoring reports from any person who has discharged, discharges, or is suspected of having discharged or discharging, or who proposes to discharge waste to waters of the United States or state. Failure to comply with requirements made pursuant to Water Code section 13267 may result in administrative civil liability pursuant to Water Code section 13268.
