The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region (San Diego Water Board) has reviewed the monitoring reports listed in the Table 1 below. The Skyline Ranch Country Club, LLC (Discharger) submitted the monitoring reports as required by the Monitoring and Reporting Program of Order No. R9-2005-0258.

The following violations Section B.1 of Order No. R9-2005-0258 (Discharge Specifications) were identified in the monitoring reports:

 The discharge specification for the 12-month average concentration of total dissolved solids (TDS) established at 720 milligrams per liter (mg/L) was exceeded on the following dates:

- 2. The discharge specification for the daily maximum concentration of total nitrogen established at 20 mg/L was exceeded on May 1, 2015 and June 3, 2016 with reported values of 21 mg/L and 20.7 mg/L, respectively.
- In future reports please calculate and report a 12-month average concentration for all constituents that have a required 12-month average discharge specification.


Please continue to implement follow-up actions necessary to ensure that the violations noted above do not occur in the future. These violations may subject the Discharger to possible further enforcement action by the San Diego Water Board including but not limited to: administrative enforcement orders requiring the Discharger to cease and desist from violations, or administrative assessments of civil liabilities in amounts of up to \$5,000 per day per violation; referral to the State Attorney General for injunctive relief; and referral to the District Attorney for criminal prosecution.

The next monitoring report required to be submitted is the January-March 2017 quarterly report, which is due by May 1, 2017.
