2. The discharge specification for total coliform exceeded 23 MPN/100 mL on February 23, 2016 and February 25, 2016 at reported values of 30 MPN/100 mL and 80 MPN/100 mL, respectively. Section A. 1 of Order No. 2000-10 specifies that the number of total coliform bacteria shall not exceed 23 MPN/100 mL more than once in a 30 day period.


The next monitoring reports required to be submitted is the January monthly monitoring report, which is due by <u>March 1, 2017</u>.

Please implement follow-up actions necessary to ensure that the violation(s) noted above do not occur in the future. These violations may subject Discharger to possible further enforcement action by the San Diego Water Board, including but not limited to: administrative enforcement orders requiring the Discharger to cease and desist from violations, or administrative assessments of civil liabilities in amounts of up to \$5,000 per day per violation; referral to the State Attorney General for injunctive relief; and referral to the District Attorney for criminal prosecution.
