Mr. Mattson:

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region (San Diego Water Board) has reviewed the monitoring reports listed below in the table. The Warner Development Company (Discharger) submitted the monitoring reports as required by the Monitoring and Reporting Program No. 93-13.

Violations of Section B.1 (Discharge Specifications) of Order No. 93-13 were identified in the monitoring reports are described below:

- 1. The discharge specification for the 12 month average concentration for nitrate, established at 30 milligrams per liter (mg/L), was exceeded on April 21, 2015 and January 30, 2016 with sample values of 52 mg/L and 42 mg/L respectively.
- 2. The discharge specification for the daily maximum concentration for nitrate, established at 45 mg/L, was exceeded on April 21, 2015 with a sample value of 60 mg/L.


The next monitoring report due is the January-June 2017 semi-annual report, which is due by July 30, 2017.

Please implement follow-up actions necessary to ensure that the violations noted above do not occur in the future. These violations may subject the Discharger to possible further enforcement action by the San Diego Water Board including but not limited to: administrative enforcement orders requiring the City to cease and desist from violations, or administrative assessments of civil liabilities in amounts of up to \$5,000 per day per violation; referral to the State Attorney General for injunctive relief; and referral to the District Attorney for criminal prosecution.
