biological integrity of receiving waters

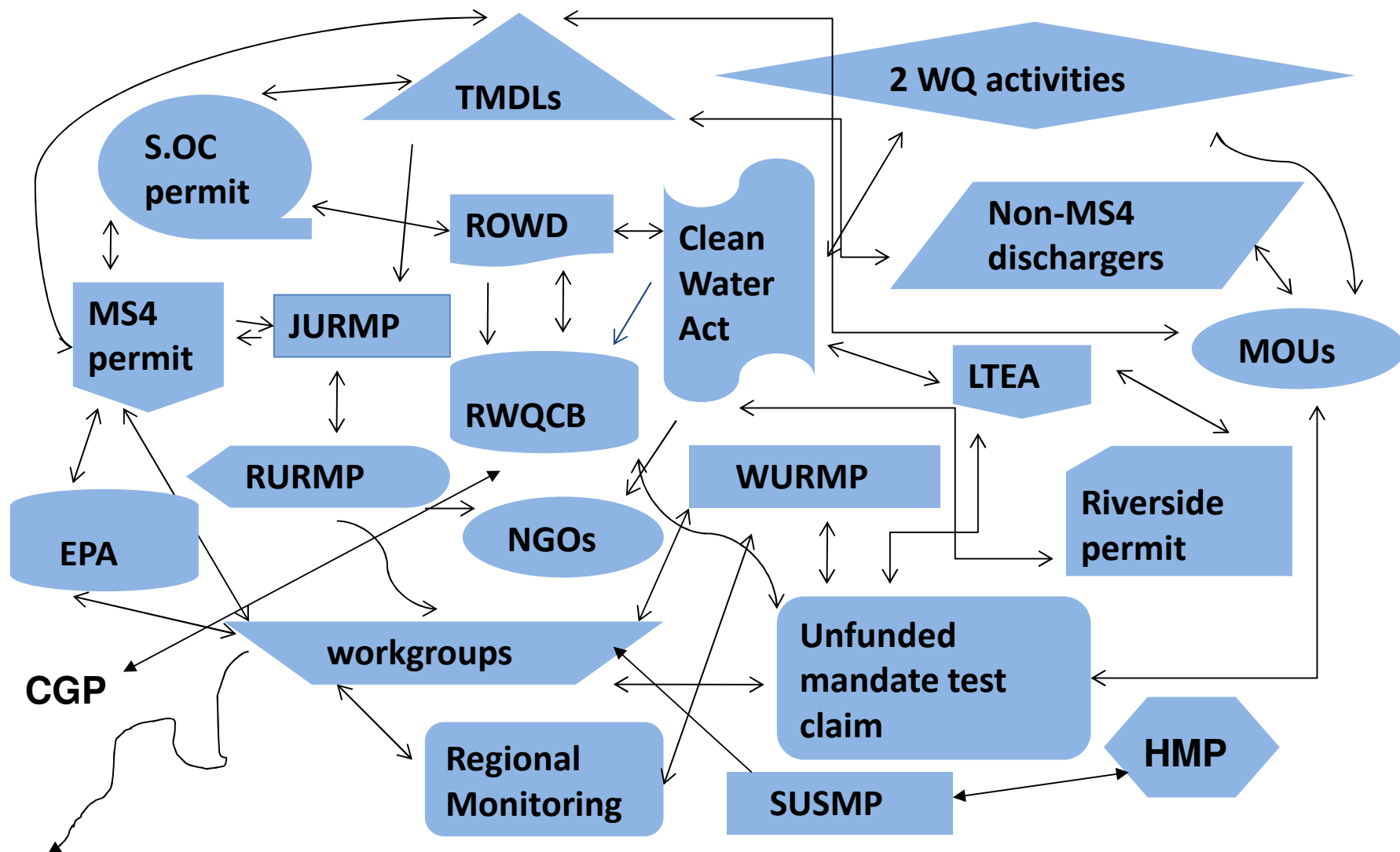
