NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region (San Diego Water Board) is scheduled to hold a public hearing to consider adoption of Tentative Order No. R9-2013-0001, NPDES No. CAS0109266, *National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit and Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Urban Runoff from the Municipal Separate Storm Sewer Systems (MS4s) Draining the Watersheds within the San Diego Region* (Tentative Order).

The Tentative Order is a regional MS4 permit that proposes to jointly cover all 39 Copermittees within the San Diego Region (i.e., South Orange County, Southwestern Riverside County, and San Diego County), in a phased manner as their current MS4 permits expire or upon request for earlier coverage prior to permit expiration. The Tentative Order covers multiple discharge points to multiple receiving waters throughout the San Diego Water Board Region. All MS4 Copermittees in the San Diego Region are therefore on notice that they may ultimately be regulated under the Tentative Order, if adopted.

The public hearing on this matter is scheduled on April 10 and 11, 2013 in the Board Room, San Diego Water Board, 9174 Sky Park Court, Suite 100, San Diego, CA 92123-4340. The item will be heard during the meetings that will start at 9:00 A.M. on each day. The location, however, may be changed prior to the meetings. All written comments including testimony, technical documentation and factual information pertaining to the terms and conditions of the Tentative Order to be considered by the San Diego Water Board were required to be submitted **by 5:00 pm on January 11, 2013**. The scope of oral testimony at the public hearing will be strictly limited to summarizing the previously submitted written comments, commenting on revisions to the Tentative Order made in response to comments, and making policy statements. No additional written materials will be accepted or provided to the San Diego Water Board Members.
