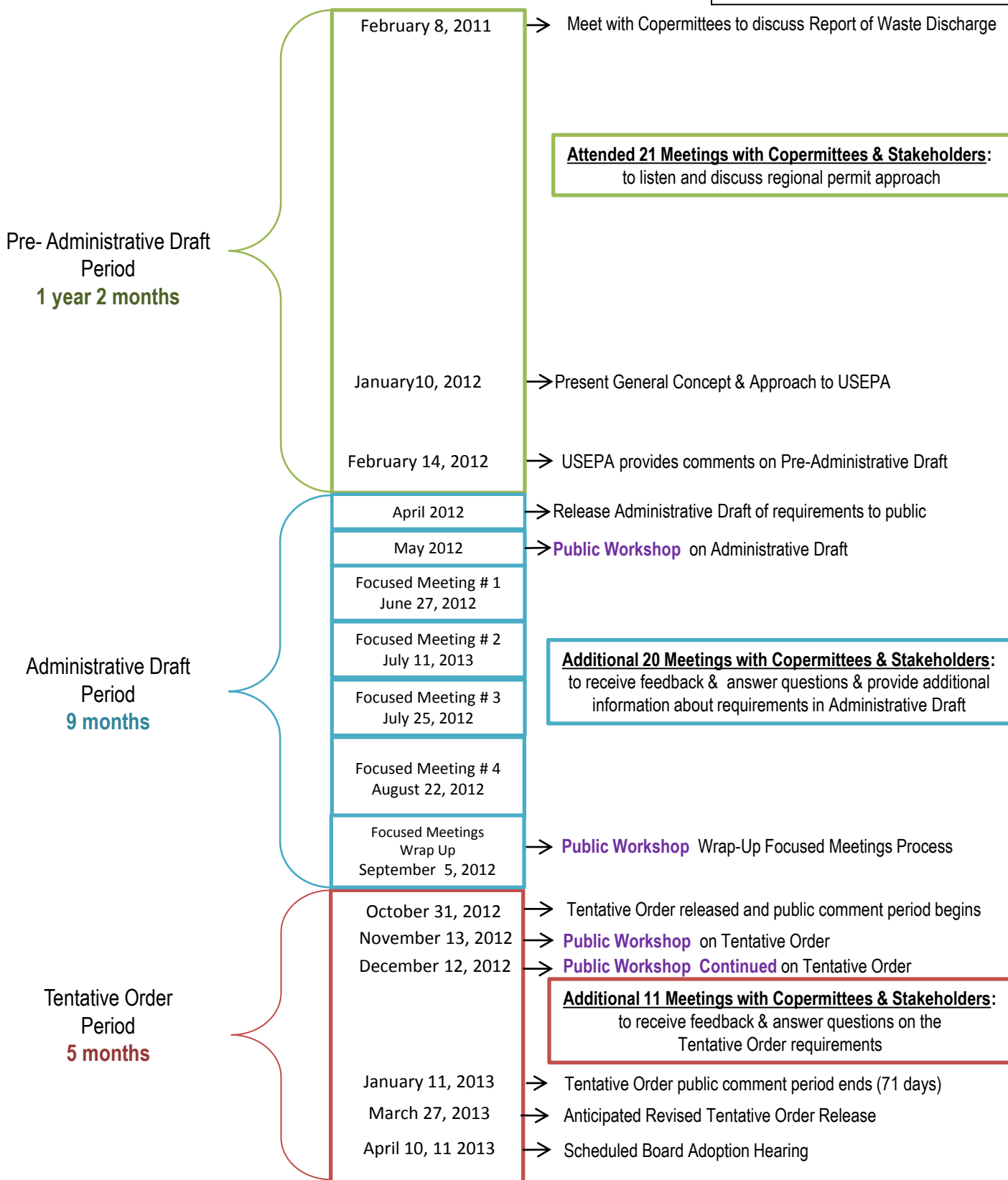

	Date	Event Description
Existing Permit Adoptions	January 24, 2007	Order No. R9-2007-0001, San Diego County Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4) Storm Water Permit adopted by San Diego Water Board.
	December 16, 2009	Order No. R9-2009-0002, Orange County MS4 Storm Water Permit adopted by San Diego Water Board.
	November 10, 2010	Order No. R9-2010-0016, Riverside County MS4 Storm Water Permit adopted by San Diego Water Board. Order No. R9-2010-0016 includes finding that announces San Diego Water Board's plans to develop a Regional Storm Water Permit (Regional MS4 Permit). Finding E.12 states: <i>The San Diego Water Board recognizes that issuing a single MS4 permit for all Phase I entities in the San Diego Region will provide consistent implementation, improve communication among agencies within watersheds crossing multiple jurisdictions, and minimize staff resources spent with each permit renewal. The San Diego Water Board plans to develop a single regional MS4 permit prior to the expiration of this Order that will transfer the Copermittees' enrollment to the regional permit upon expiration of this Order.</i>
