ADDENDUM NO. 1 TO ORDER NO. 86-48

AN ADDENDUM TRANSFERRING RESPONSIBILITY  
FOR ORDER NO. 86-48  
FROM  
CONVAIR RECREATION ASSOCIATION  
TO  
WARREN-NEELY FOUNDATION, INC.  
PINECREST PARK  
SAN DIEGO COUNTY

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region (hereinafter Regional Board), finds that:


1. On June 16, 1986, this Regional Board adopted Order No. 86-48, "**Waste Discharge Requirements For the Convaire Recreation Association, Pinecrest Park, San Diego County.**" Order No. 86-48 established requirements for the disposal of up to 10,000 gallons per day of domestic sewage effluent from a campground by irrigation of nursery stock, and similar growths.
2. By letter dated June 16, 1995, Jan Stone of Warren-Neely Foundation, Inc. notified the Regional Board that as of June 16, 1995 they were the new owner and operator of Pinecrest Park, now called Pinecrest Community Center.
3. The Regional Board has notified all known interested parties of its intent to modify Order No. 86-48 to reflect the transfer of responsibility for complying with Order No. 86-48.
4. The Regional Board in a public hearing heard and considered all comments pertaining to the modification of Order No. 86-48.
5. This facility is an existing facility and as such is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act, in accordance with Title 14, California Code of Regulations, Article 19, Section 15301.

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED**, that Order No. 86-48 is modified as follows:

1. Order No. 86-48 shall henceforth be referred to as **Waste Discharge Requirements for the Warren-Neely Foundation Inc., Pinecrest Community Center, San Diego County.**
2. The waste discharge requirements contained in Order No. 86-48 shall be applicable to the Warren-Neely Foundation, Inc. and shall remain in full force and effect.

3. The word discharger as it appears in Order No. 86-48 shall hereafter be construed to refer to the Warren-Neely Foundation, Inc.
