**SUBJECT: ADDENDUM NO. 1 TO CLEANUP AND ABATEMENT ORDER NO. R9-2002-0024 AT ARCO SERVICE STATION #3012, 27641 YNEZ ROAD, TEMECULA, CALIFORNIA**

Enclosed is Addendum No. 1 to Cleanup and Abatement Order (CAO) No. R9-2002-0024. The Order directs you to cleanup and abate the effects of the discharges of petroleum wastes at 27641 Ynez Road, Temecula, California that resulted from leaking underground storage tank systems at the site.

Addendum No.1 to CAO No. R9-2002-0024 is issued pursuant to California Water Code (CWC) sections 13267 and 13304, and requests the submission of a complete Corrective Action Plan no later than November 17, 2003.

Failure to meet the deadline may subject you to further enforcement action by the Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region, (Regional Board). You may contest the issuance of this CAO Addendum by requesting a public hearing on the matter before the Regional Board. In order to schedule a hearing this office must receive a written request within 30 days of this letter.

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region (hereinafter Regional Board) finds that:

1. A due date for the Corrective Action Plan (CAP) for cleanup of petroleum hydrocarbon wastes from soil and groundwater at ARCO Service Station #3012, required by Directive A.5 of Cleanup and Abatement Order (CAO) No. R9-2002-0024, was not set by the Regional Board because of uncertainty regarding the time needed by Atlantic Richfield Company (the discharger) to complete the soil and groundwater investigation of the extent of wastes and pollution at the site.
2. The soil and groundwater investigation was completed and a technical report of the investigation was submitted to the Regional Board on June 2, 2003 in fulfillment of Directive A.4 of the CAO. The soil and groundwater investigation provided the data and information necessary to prepare the CAP. Subsequently, the discharger submitted a draft CAP dated August 20, 2003. A due date for the final CAP is needed.
3. This action is an Order to enforce the laws and regulations administered by the Regional Board. As such, this action is categorically exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to section 15321 of the Resources Agency Guidelines.

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED**, pursuant to sections 13267 and 13304 of the California Water Code, that the dischargers shall cleanup and abate the effects of the discharge as follows:

The due date for submission of the final Corrective Action Plan, required by Directive A.5 of CAO No. R9-2002-0024, is **November 17, 2003**.
