DISCUSSION: The County of Orange requested time at the April 12, 2006 meeting

for a presentation on water quality efforts conducted within the

County. Similar time was allocated at the May 2005 Board meeting in Laguna Beach, where the County and other organizations provided information on the Municipal Storm Water Program and on efforts to

improve water quality in Aliso Creek and coastal waters.

Written information on the presentations may be provided in a

subsequent mailing to the Regional Board members.

Also, the Municipal Storm Water NPDES Permit (Regional Board Order No. R9-2002-01) is the primary regulatory mechanism for addressing surface water quality in southern Orange County. The current NPDES Permit expires in February 2007, and the Report of

Waste Discharge for the Permit renewal is due in July 2006.
