Certification for the fill of 0.07 acres (1,375 linear feet) of waters of the State and U.S. The proposed project is a commercial development including a Professional Hospital Supply warehouse, extension of Remington Road, and widening portions of both Winchester Road and Dendy

Parkway.

DISCUSSION: By e-mail dated January 30, 2008 and February 6, 2008, the

project proponent submitted their plan to install 3

StormFilters by Contech Stormwater Solutions to achieve medium to high pollutant removal efficiencies. These StormFilters will treat water from the 4 storm water inlets which previously had a low pollutant removal efficiency. The errata sheet changes the Order and Fact sheet to reflect this

change in storm water treatment technology.

KEY ISSUE: The discharger has evaluated alternatives to the proposed

low pollutant removal efficiency inlet inserts and plans to install StormFilters to achieve the required pollutant removal

rate.
