

**NOTICE OF SETTLEMENT**

California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region Settlement of Administrative Civil

Liability Against  
Fallbrook Public Utility District  
Fallbrook Creek Sewage Discharge  
Fallbrook, California

On October 17, 2007, the California Regional Water Quality Board, San Diego Region (Regional Board) issued Complaint No. R9-2007-0101 to the Fallbrook Public Utility District (FPUD) in the amount of \$29,300 for alleged of Order No. 96-04, General Waste Discharge Requirements Prohibiting Sanitary Sewer Overflows by Sewage Collection Agencies. The FPUD and Regional Board have reached a settlement agreement concerning the liability of \$29,300 recommended in the Complaint. The Regional Board will consider approval of an Administrative Civil Liability (ACL) Order implementing the settlement agreement at the regularly meeting tentatively scheduled for March 12, 2008.

The settlement conditions include: a) payment of \$20,000 to the State Water Resources Control Board, within 30 business days of approval of an ACL Order implementing the Settlement Agreement by the Regional Board, for deposit in an account administered for Cleanup and Abatement activities and b) the remaining \$9,300 of the liability to be suspended pending FPUD's submission of evidence of satisfactory completion of purchase and installation of three "SmartCover" monitoring units.

Written comments from interested parties, regarding the settlement agreement for ACL Complaint No. R9-2007-0101 will be accepted through Monday, March 3, 2008.

The Regional Board has tentatively scheduled regular meeting on March 12, 2008 to be held at the Regional Board office located at 9174 Sky Park Court, San Diego, California. The meeting will begin at 9:00 a.m. Oral comments for this item may be made during the meeting upon receipt of a request to speak slip.
