SUBJECT: TENTATIVE ADDENDUM NO. 1 TO ORDER NO. 95-018 SKINNER LAKE RECREATION AREA

Enclosed is a copy of tentative Addendum No. 1 to Order No. 95-018, *An Addendum Modifying Dissolved Oxygen Monitoring Requirements for the Skinner Lake Recreation Area Oxidation Ponds*, which is scheduled to be considered for adoption by the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region (Regional Board). If adopted, the tentative Addendum will allow the Riverside County Regional Park & Open Space District (District) to measure dissolved oxygen concentrations in the oxidation ponds with a portable dissolved oxygen meter, and would require the District to notify the Regional Board if the dissolved oxygen concentration in the oxidation ponds falls below 2.0 mg/L.

The tentative Addendum will be considered for adoption by the Regional Board at their scheduled meeting on Wednesday, April 8, 2009. The meeting will begin promptly at 9:00 AM and will be held at the following location:

Please review and comment on the tentative Addendum at your earliest convenience. Written comments should be submitted as soon as possible to enable staff to amend the tentative Addendum, if necessary, and allow changes to the tentative Addendum to be fully reviewed by the Regional Board and interested persons. To ensure that the Regional Board has the opportunity to fully study and consider written material, comments should be received in the Regional Board's office no later than 5:00 P.M. on

Per Regional Board direction, written material submitted to the Regional Board office after this final submittal deadline date <u>will not</u> be provided to the Regional Board.
