SUBJECT: REVISED TENTATIVE ORDER NO. R9-2009-0036; AN ORDER RESCINDING ORDER NO. R9-2002-0067, NPDES NO. CA0109371, WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR S & S FARMS SWINE RAISING FACILITY, SAN DIEGO COUNTY

Enclosed is a copy of tentative Order No. R9-2009-0036 (previously Order No. R9-2008-0123), which the Regional Board staff intends to present to the Regional Board for adoption at their regularly scheduled meeting on March 11, 2009.

If adopted tentative Order No. R9-2009-0036 would rescind Waste Discharge Requirements and NPDES permit for the S & S Farms Swine Raising Facility.

Waste Discharges that do not cause or have the potential to cause significant impacts to the quality of the waters of the state may be covered under the Regional Board's Waiver Policy. A Notice of Intent was received on November 12, 2008 from your facility to be covered under the Waiver Policy.

Please note that the tentative Order had previously been released for public review on September 23, 2008 (as tentative Order No. R9-2008-0123). Modifications were made to the tentative Order to clarify language and to change the Order number.
