- SUBJECT: Update of Waste Discharge Requirements: Ramona Municipal Water District San Vicente Wastewater Treatment Plant, San Diego County, Issuance of Master Reclamation Permit (Tentative Order No. R9-2009-0005) (*Cathryn Henning*)
- PURPOSE: To adopt tentative Order No. R9-2009-0005, which will update the requirements for the treatment and reuse of up to 0.8 million gallons per day of recycled water by the Ramona Municipal Water District (District).
- DISCUSSION: Enclosed are Supporting Documents Nos. 4, 5, and 6.
- Supporting Document No. 4 summarizes the verbal comments provided by the District on the tentative Order and the responses to those comments by the Groundwater Basins Branch.
- Supporting Document No. 5 presents the errata for the tentative Order, which includes format and typographical revisions and changes that concur with the District's comments. These changes include increasing the limitation for the 30-day average flowrate from 0.75 million gallons per day (MGD) to 0.8 MGD, and replacing the numerical discharge limitation in Table 3 for nitrate-nitrogen with a narrative requirement for implementation of applicable nutrient management measures.
