The San Diego Water Board will consider adoption of a resolution to amend Conditional Waiver No. 4 for Agricultural and Nursery Operations (one of 11 conditional waivers in the Basin Plan) to define the term "agricultural and nursery operations" as it appears in the waiver. The proposed definition specifies that only commercial operations that generate gross sales of at least \$1,000 per year, as an average, are subject to the waiver's requirements.
