

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
CALIFORNIA REGIONAL WATER QUALITY CONTROL BOARD
SAN DIEGO REGION**

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region, (San Diego Water Board) intends to consider issuing a time schedule order (Tentative Order No. R9-2011-0052) to Kinder Morgan Energy Partners to demonstrate that the discharge of treated groundwater from its Mission Valley Terminal remediation dewatering project to Murphy Canyon Creek does not cause, or contribute to an in-stream excursion above the water quality objective for total dissolved solids as established in the Water Quality Control Plan for the San Diego Region.

The San Diego Water Board is seeking public input on this matter and will hear oral comments at its meeting on August 10, 2011 at 9:00 a.m. in the San Diego Water Board Meeting Room, 9174 Sky Park Court, San Diego, California. For the accuracy of the record, significant comments should be submitted in writing. The San Diego Water Board expects commenters to summarize their written comments. Oral comments raising significant new issues not raised during the written comment period will not be permitted.

The final deadline for submittal of written comments is 5:00 P.M. on Wednesday, July 27, 2011. Written comments received after this date will not be provided to the San Diego Water Board members prior to the hearing.
