<u>California Environmental Quality Act</u> (CEQA) Compliance Documentation

The regulations governing issuance of water quality certifications contained in CCR title 23, section 3856(f) require Wildlands to submit a valid final CEQA document that the San Diego Water Board can rely on in considering the issuance of the Tentative Certification. The San Diego Water Board received the Final Mitigated Negative Declaration for the San Luis Rey Mitigation Bank Project on June 29, 2014 and has added the document to the agenda package as Supporting Document No. 5.

San Luis Rey Mitigation Bank Development Plan

Section V.C of the Tentative Certification requires Wildands to implement the *San Luis Rey Mitigation Bank Development Plan* (Development Plan), dated November 2012, which is incorporated in the Tentative Certification by reference. The Development Plan describes the restoration design for implementation of the Project and the methods that will be used to monitor the site in order to document progress of the habitat towards meeting approved ecological success performance standards. The Development Plan has been added to the agenda package as Supporting Document No. 6.
