This serves to inform you that the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region (San Diego Water Board) will consider adoption of Tentative Order No. R9-2015-0104, *Master Recycling Permit for the Valley Center Municipal Water District, Woods Valley Ranch Water Reclamation Facility, San Diego County* (Tentative Order) at its scheduled meeting on Wednesday, December 16, 2015. The Tentative Order, if adopted, would prescribe requirements for the discharge of tertiary treated recycled water from the Woods Valley Water Reclamation Facility. 
