This letter serves to inform you that the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region (San Diego Water Board) will consider adoption of Tentative Order No. R9-2016-0128 (Tentative Order) at its scheduled meeting on Wednesday, September 14, 2016. The Tentative Order, if adopted, would rescind Order No. 94-74, Waste Discharge Requirements for Milo and Joan Crouse, Lilac Oaks Campground, San Diego County.

The San Diego Water Board intends to enroll the Lilac Oaks Campground Onsite Wastewater Treatment System in Order No. WQ 2014-0153-DWQ, *General Waste Discharge Requirements for Small Domestic Wastewater Treatment Systems* (General Order),<sup>1</sup> after the Order No. 94-74 has been rescinded. You will receive a Notice of Applicability enrolling the discharge from your facility in the General Order in the near future.

Subject: Tentative Order No. R9-2016-0128: An Order Rescinding Order No. R9-2009-0007 for Rowland Residence Onsite Wastewater Treatment System

Ms. Rowland:

This letter serves to inform you that the California Regional Water Quality Control Board San Diego Region (San Diego Water Board) will be deferring regulation of your Onsite Wastewater Treatment System (OWTS) to the County of San Diego Department of Environmental Health (County DEH), and will rescind Order No. R9-2009-0007 (see details on page 2). Order No. R9-2009-0007 prescribes waste discharge requirements (WDRs) for the treatment and discharge of domestic wastewater from the OWTS, which serves your single family residence located at 3605 Fortuna Road in Encinitas, San Diego County (APN # 264-101-54).

#### State Water Board Policy and Deferral to San Diego County DEH

In accordance with Water Code section 13269, the State Water Board can waive the requirements<sup>1</sup> to obtain WDRs, submit a Report of Waste Discharge, and pay fees for discharges from OWTS, provided those systems have a design flow of less than 10,000 gallons per day and they meet all the requirements of County DEH *Local Agency Management Plan for Onsite Wastewater Treatment Systems*.<sup>2</sup> Please contact the County of San Diego Department of Environmental Health (County DEH),<sup>3</sup> about its local permitting requirements for the OWTS on your property.

In addition, you must comply with the following conditions specified in section 12.0 of the State Water Board *Water* OWTS Policy:

- 1. The OWTS shall function as designed with no surfacing effluent.
- 2. The OWTS shall not utilize a dispersal system that is in soil saturated with groundwater.
- 3. The OWTS shall not be operated while inundated by a storm or flood event.
- 4. The OWTS shall not cause or contribute to a condition of nuisance or pollution.
- 5. The OWTS shall comply with the applicable local agency codes, ordinances, and requirements.<sup>4</sup>
- 6. The OWTS shall comply with and meet any applicable Total Maximum Daily Load implementation requirements, special provisions for impaired water bodies, or supplemental treatment requirements imposed by Tier 3 of the OWTS Policy.
- 7. The OWTS shall comply with any corrective action requirements in Tier 4 of the OWTS Policy.

## San Diego Water Board Meeting and Rescission of Order No. R9-2009-0007

The San Diego Water Board is scheduled to consider adoption of Tentative Order No. R9-2016-0128 at its meeting on September 14, 2016. The enclosed Tentative Order No. R9-2016-0128, if adopted, would rescind Order No. R9-2009-0007. The San Diego Water Board has also notified the County DEH of the proposed action.

Mr. Brower:

This letter serves to inform you that the California Regional Water Quality Control Board San Diego Region (San Diego Water Board) will consider rescinding Order No. R9-2012-0056 at its scheduled meeting on Wednesday, September 14, 2016. Order No. R9-2012-0056 establishes requirements for the treatment and disposal of domestic wastewater from a proposed advanced Onsite Wastewater Treatment System (OWTS). Order No. R9-2012-0056 prescribes waste discharge requirements (or WDRs) for the construction and operation of an OWTS that was intended to serve a single family residence to be built at APN 186-612-31, located on Camino Elena Road in Escondido, San Diego County. Enclosed is a copy of Tentative Order No. R9-2016-0128. If adopted, Tentative Order No. R9-2016-0128 would rescind Order No. R9-2012-0056.

The San Diego Water Board was informed by the previous owner of the property, Mr. William Leuthe, that you purchased the property on November 14, 2013. As of October 7, 2014, the residence and OWTS had not been constructed. 1 The San Diego Water Board has not received formal notification of the ownership transfer in writing, and as a result has been unable to amend Order No. R9-2012-0056 to reflect the ownership change. The San Diego Water Board is rescinding Order No. R9-2012-0056 to prevent you from incurring any further waste discharge requirements fees.

Please contact the San Diego Water Board and the County of San Diego Department of Environmental Health (County DEH),<sup>2</sup> prior to installing an OWTS on the subject property. The San Diego Water Board has deferred to the County DEH regulation of all OWTS with design flows less than 10,000 gallons per day and the State Water Board provides a conditional
