DISCUSSION:	Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton (MCBCP) submitted written comments regarding the Tentative Order on April 23, 2018. The San Diego Water Board has incorporated the MCBCP comments into the Revised Tentative Order, shown in redline and strikeout text in Supporting Document No. 5. The following sections of the Tentative Order have been revised: Attachment D - page D-5, Monitoring and Reporting Program Table 1, and Attachment D - page D-6, Monitoring and Reporting Program Table 2. The written comments and the San Diego Water Board responses can be found in Supporting Document No. 6.
	The MCBCP comments requested the addition of bicarbonate to the effluent monitoring in order to calculate the adjusted sodium adsorption ratio. Bicarbonate was also added to the annual groundwater chemistry evaluation and comparison between the injection zone, shallow aquifer, and effluent from the Southern Regional Tertiary Treatment Plant.
