- 6,251 Dry Metric Tons (dmt) produced
- 5,172 dmt Class A to Yuma
- 518 dmt Class B to Yuma
- 560 PureGreen to Nurseries, Fertilizer wholesaler's, FAA

2019 Imperial Country measure X repealed. 2019 650 dmt to IC.

Class A product has tendency to reheat.

• 13,482 Mwh 210,640,000 scf


2016

• 12,963 Mwh 203,226,000 scf


December 2017 digester gas annual limit was increased to 280 million scf from 224 million scf.

Alternative fuel receiving facility currently accepts brewery waste and FOG from grease traps.


EWPCF Projected Flows from Recent Process Master Plan

Maximize use of EWPCF with Potable Reuse (2040 Summer Flows)



- Develop partnerships with water agencies

 - Private investment (Poseidon, P3s)
