The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region (San Diego Water Board), is releasing Tentative Addendum No. 1 to Order No. 87-54, *Waste Discharge Requirements for the City of San Diego West Miramar Solid Waste Disposal Facility, San Diego County* (Tentative Addendum), for public review and comment. The San Diego Water Board will consider adoption of the Tentative Addendum at its regularly scheduled meeting on **November 10, 2021**. The Tentative Addendum, if adopted, will modify Order No. 87-54, *Waste Discharge Requirements for the City of San Diego West Miramar Solid Waste Disposal Facility, San Diego County*.

The written comment period provides an opportunity for interested persons to comment on the Tentative Addendum. All written comments regarding the Tentative Addendum must be received no later than **5:00 p.m. on Monday, September 20, 2021**, to be considered by the San Diego Water Board. Early submission of written comments on the Tentative Addendum is encouraged. Written comments received by **5:00 p.m. on Monday, September 20, 2021**, will be provided to the San Diego Water Board members for their review in advance of the public hearing to consider adoption of the Tentative Addendum. The San Diego Water Board will prepare written responses to significant comments that are timely received.

Consistent with State Water Resources Control Board regulations that apply to this proceeding, written comments received after **5:00 p.m. on Monday, September 20, 2021**, will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party.
