**NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT AND PUBLIC HEARING**

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region (San Diego Water Board) is releasing, for public review and comment Tentative Order No. R9-2021-0020, *Waste Discharge Requirements for Strata Keith, LLC, Horizons/Approved Tract Map No. 36672 Project, Riverside County* (Tentative Order).

The San Diego Water Board is considering adoption of the Tentative Order in response to a Report of Waste Discharger (ROWD) application submitted by Strata Keith, LLC (Discharger) for the discharge of permanent fill material to 0.12 acre (1,041 linear feet) of ephemeral streambed surface waters of the State from the Horizons/Approved Tract Map No. 36672 Project (Project). The Project is located within the City of Wildomar, Riverside County, California, northwest of the intersection of Prielipp Road and Elizabeth Lane.

The Tentative Order authorizes unavoidable direct impacts by the Project to the ephemeral streambed and riparian waters and requires the Discharger to implement compensatory mitigation sufficient to offset the permanent impacts. Under the terms of the Tentative Order, the Discharger must provide assurance that replacement of the full range of lost aquatic resource(s) and/or functions through compensatory mitigation will be provided in perpetuity.
