The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region (San Diego Water Board), will consider adoption of the enclosed Tentative Cleanup and Abatement Order No R9-2023-0102, an *Order Directing Citizens Development Corporation, Symphony Asset Pool XXI LLC, LSM Golf Course Partners LLC, Hollandia Dairy Inc., Wilgenburg Dairy, City of San Marcos, City of Escondido, Vallecitos Water District, and County of San Diego To Clean Up or Abate Effects Of Waste Discharged To Lake San Marcos And San Marcos Creek, San Diego County* (Tentative CAO), at its regularly scheduled meeting on March 13, 2024.

Written material submitted to the San Diego Water Board office after the submittal deadline may not be considered.

After the comment deadline, the San Diego Water Board staff will present the comments received, along with any necessary responses or suggested modifications to the Tentative CAO, to the San Diego Water Board for consideration and action. The San Diego Water Board will copy you and all "Interested Persons" when transmitting the comments, responses, and the Tentative CAO to the Board members for consideration and action. Interested persons are copied at the conclusion of this letter. The San Diego Water Board staff may not present written responses or suggested modifications prior to the March 13, 2024, Board meeting, but instead may do so at the hearing.

The Tentative CAO under consideration is consistent with all applicable laws and policies of the State Water Resources Control Board. To assist in your review and understanding of the Tentative CAO, consider reviewing all the San Diego Water Board documents associated with the case. These documents are available for review at the San Diego Water Board office Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., except on state holidays.
