PUBLIC NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY FLOW, ENTRAINMENT AND IMPINGEMENT MINIMIZATION PLAN POSEIDON RESOURCES CORPORATION CARLSBAD DESALINATION PROJECT

This is to notify interested persons that a copy of a draft "Flow, Entrainment and Impingement Minimization Plan" (Plan) is available for public review and comment. This Plan describes procedures and activities proposed by Poseidon Resources Corporation to minimize environmental impact on marine life in the vicinity of the Carlsbad Desalination Plant during temporary or permanent shutdown or reduction of cooling water flow at the Encina Power Generation Station.


Project Description

On August 16, 2006, this Regional Board adopted Order No. R9-2006-065 (NPDES Permit No. CA0109223) Waste Discharge Requirements For The Poseidon Resources Corporation, Carlsbad Desalination Project, Discharge To The Pacific Ocean Via The Encina Power Station Discharge Channel. Provision VI.C.2.e of the Order states the following:

The Discharger shall submit a Flow, Entrainment and Impingement Minimization Plan within 180 days of adoption of the Order. The plan shall assess the feasibility of site- specific plans, procedures, and practices to be implemented and/or mitigation measures to minimize the impacts to marine organisms when the CDP intake requirements exceed the volume of water being discharged by the EPS. The plan shall be subject to the approval of the Regional Water Board and shall be modified as directed by the Regional Water Board.

This Provision was included in Order No. R9-2006-065 to ensure Poseidon Resources Corporation applies the best available site, design, technology, and mitigation measures that are feasible to minimize the intake and mortality of all forms of marine life during periods when the Desalination Plant requires more seawater than is needed by the Encina Power Generation Station. Provision VI.C.2.e is consistent with California Water Code Section 13142.5(b).
