**NOTICE OF PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD**

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region (San Diego Water Board), has received Water Quality Improvement Plan (WQIP) updates for the San Luis Rey Watershed and San Diego Bay (Spring Valley) Watershed for public review and comment. These WQIPs have been revised to incorporate the B.3.c Prohibitions and Limitations Compliance Option and are available on the Regional Clearinghouse, pursuant to Provision F of Order No. R9-2013-0001, as amended (Order). The San Diego Water Board will consider all comments received during this review period and will report any identified deficiencies to the Executive Officer. During implementation of the Prohibitions and Limitations Compliance Option, the Copermitees must correct all deficiencies identified by the San Diego Water Board.
