NOTICE OF WRITTEN COMMENT PERIOD

Recommendations for Changes to Monitoring Locations in the Unified Beach Water Quality Monitoring and Assessment Program in Southern Orange County

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region (San Diego Water Board) is planning to approve the relocation of (five) monitoring locations under the *Unified Beach Water Quality Monitoring and Assessment Program* as shown in attached Figures 1-3 (Attached). These changes are intended to promote effective protection of public health by addressing sampling access issues, better serving the monitoring needs of the Total Maximum Daily Load (TMDL) program, and to better target specific areas of recreation.

Pursuant to the directive issued under California Water Code 13383 on December 05, 2014, the San Diego Water Board will receive written comments on the proposed changes by **5:00 p.m. on April 12, 2018**.
