The San Diego water Board intends to issue a no further action letter for cleanup at Military Underground Storage Tank Sites 1014, 1015, and 1016 at Building 379, Naval Air Station North Island, Coronado, California. This public notice fulfills the San Diego Water Board's obligation to inform the public of completed corrective action as required by California Code of Regulations (CCR), Title 23, Division 3, Chapter 16, Article 11, section 2728.

The 60-day public notification period ends on June 27, 2025. Any comments provided regarding this matter will be considered by the San Diego Water Board.
