The San Diego Water Board intends to issue a no further action letter for cleanup of an unauthorized release of total petroleum hydrocarbons as diesel (TPH-d) dissolved into groundwater at P750 Rotary Hangar Underground Storage Tank Site - Naval Air Station North Island, San Diego, California. This public notice fulfills the San Diego Water Board's obligation to inform the public of completed corrective action as required by California Code of Regulations (CCR), Title 23, Division 3, Chapter 16, Article 11, section 2728.

The 30-day public notification period ends on March 17, 2026. Any comments provided regarding this matter will be considered by the San Diego Water Board. The case files are available for public review by submitting a file review request to the San Diego Water Board office, or on-line from the GeoTracker database:
