The San Diego Water Board intends to issue a no further action letter for cleanup of an unauthorized release of petroleum fuel wastes from leaking underground storage tanks 620-1 and 620-2 at Former Building 620, Naval Air Station North Island, Coronado, California (Site). This public notice fulfills the San Diego Water Board's obligation to inform the public of completed corrective action as required by California Code of Regulations, title 23, division 3, chapter 16, article 11, section 2728.
