Tentative Ag WDRs, section A.4

"For the purposes of this Order, are those Operations which generate less than \$1,000 in gross sales of agricultural or nursery products, or would have been grown and sold during the previous years, but for an event beyond the control of the Discharger."






MONITORING NETWORK AND DISTRIBUTION

COST ESTIMATIONS

- Laboratory and Field Sample Collection
 - Monitoring Station/Year ≈ \$9,800
 - Monitoring Station/5-Year Period ≈ \$49,000
 - Cost Difference (Waiver vs. General WDRs) ≈ \$41,000
 - Cost Increase ≈ 500%
