NOTICE OF WRITTEN COMMENT PERIOD FOR TENTATIVE SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT AND STIPULATION FOR ENTRY OF ADMINISTRATIVE CIVIL LIABILITY ORDER NO. R9-2020-0109

IN THE MATTER OF THE CITY OF SOLANA BEACH SOLANA BEACH PUMP STATION GROUNDWATER EXTRACTION PROJECT DISCHARGE TO THE PACIFIC OCEAN

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region (San Diego Water Board) is considering the adoption of Settlement Agreement and Stipulation for Entry of Administrative Civil Liability Order (Stipulated Order) No. R9-2020-0109. The Stipulated Order is a settlement agreement between the City of Solana Beach (City) and the San Diego Water Board's Prosecution Team to address mandatory minimum penalties associated with alleged serious effluent violations of Order No. R9-2015-0013, General Waste Discharge Requirements for Groundwater Extraction Discharges to Surface Waters within the San Diego Region.

To resolve the alleged violations without formal administrative proceedings, the City has agreed to the final imposition of an administrative civil liability in the amount of \$9,000, the mandatory minimum penalty amount required by Water Code section 13385.
