# NOTICE OF WRITTEN COMMENT PERIOD FOR TENTATIVE SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT AND STIPULATION FOR ENTRY OF ADMINISTRATIVE CIVIL LIABILITY ORDER NO. R9-2020-0013

### IN THE MATTER OF SOUTH ORANGE COUNTY WASTEWATER AUTHORITY ALISO CREEK OCEAN OUTFALL

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region (San Diego Water Board) is considering the adoption of Settlement Agreement and Stipulation for Entry of Administrative Civil Liability Order (Stipulated Order) No. R9-2020-0013. The Stipulated Order is a settlement agreement between South Orange County Wastewater Authority (SOCWA) and the San Diego Water Board's Prosecution Team to address mandatory minimum penalties associated with alleged serious effluent violations of Order No. R9-2012-0013, Waste Discharge Requirements for the South Orange County Wastewater Authority Discharge to the Pacific Ocean Through the Aliso Creek Ocean Outfall.

To resolve the alleged violations without formal administrative proceedings, SOCWA has agreed to the final imposition of an administrative civil liability in the amount of \$6,000, the mandatory minimum penalty amount required by Water Code section 13385.
