Enclosed is **Notice of Violation (NOV) No. R9-2009-0093** for Hanson Elementary School located in Ramona, California. The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region (Regional Board) identified the violations cited in the enclosed NOV during review of the following Self Monitoring Reports required by Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR) Order No. R9-2004-0409:

Regional Board Comments

In addition, the Regional Board has the following comments:

- 1. On August 2, 2006, the Regional Board issued a NOV noting several violations of Order No. R9-2004-0409. In response to the NOV Advanced Onsite Systems on behalf of the Ramona Unified School District (District), provided two reports dated September 5, 2006 and May 1, 2007 to look into the cause of the violations. The Regional Board would like to continue discussion on the findings of these reports in order to determine how the District can best comply with regulations regarding the onsite wastewater treatment system at Hanson Elementary School. Ms. Cathryn Henning of my staff will contact you to arrange a meeting to discuss violations of Order performance requirements, operational concerns, and feasible solutions to reduce contaminant loading to the groundwater basin.
- 2. Submitted monitoring reports are currently signed by the contracted operator, Water Quality Specialists, and do not provide any indication to the Regional Board that the operator is communicating with management at the Ramona Unified School District. Future monitoring reports must be signed by management at the Ramona Unified School District in order to ensure the District is aware of water quality issues associated with the onsite wastewater treatment system at Hanson Elementary School.
- Order No. R9-2004-0409 prescribes 12-month average performance requirements for groundwater samples collected from MW3, MW4, and MW5. In

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future reports submitted to the Regional Board, please calculate and report the 12-month averages for total dissolved solids, nitrate (as NO₃), boron, chloride, sulfate, manganese, fluoride, methylene blue activated substances, and iron for all effluent and groundwater samples.

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4. Review of the boring log and well construction of MW5 indicates that the well is screened from 23 feet below ground surface (bgs) to 121 feet bgs. This well screen encounters a confining granite layer at 20 feet bgs and a confined aquifer at 100 feet bgs. Due to the length of and the depth to the screened interval of MW5, samples collected from this well are likely not representative of the unconfined aquifer and not a good indicator of compliance with performance requirements. The Regional Board requests destruction of MW5 to prevent possible migration of groundwater in the unconfined layer to the deeper confined layer. A replacement of this well is not necessary at this time.

The next monitoring reports required to be submitted are the 2009 second quarter and 2009 semiannual reports. These reports are due by August 1, 2009.

Waste Discharge Requirements: Order No. R9-2004-0409

YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED THAT:

The Ramona Unified School District (Discharger) violated Order No. R9-2004-0409, Waste Discharge Requirements for the Ramona Unified School District, Hanson Elementary School, San Diego County. These violations subject the Discharger to possible further enforcement action by the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region (Regional Board), including administrative enforcement orders requiring you to cease and desist from violations, or to clean up waste and abate existing or threatened conditions of pollution or nuisance; administrative assessment of civil liability in amounts of up to \$5,000 per day per violation; referral to the State Attorney General for injunctive relief; and referral to the District Attorney for criminal prosecution.

Daily maximum and 12-month average exceedances of performance requirements for nitrate as NO₃ in compliance wells MW3, MW4, and MW5 were identified for a total of 102 violations of Order No. R9-2004-0409.

Summary of Violations

1. VIOLATIONS OF PERFORMANCE REQUIREMENT B.1

The 12-month average performance requirement for nitrate as NO₃ in the groundwater is 9 milligrams per liter (mg/L). The following table summarizes the 9 violations of the nitrate as NO₃ 12-month average performance requirement in each compliance well:
