SUBJECT: NOTICE OF VIOLATION NO. R9-2009-0114
CARLSBAD WATER RECYCLING FACILITY

Enclosed is Notice of Violation (NOV) No. R9-2009-0114 for Carlsbad Water Recycling Facility (Carlsbad WRF). The basis for this NOV was the monitoring data contained in the August 2008 through April 2009 monthly reports; the July - September 2008, October - December 2008, and January - March 2009 quarterly monitoring reports; and the January - December 2008 annual monitoring report. These monitoring reports were submitted by the Carlsbad Municipal Water District (District) in accordance with Monitoring and Reporting Program No. 2001-352.

Please take steps to implement the follow-up actions necessary to ensure that the violations noted do not occur in the future. These violations subject the District to possible further enforcement action by the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region (Regional Board), including administrative enforcement orders requiring the District to cease and desist from violations, or to clean up waste and abate existing or threatened conditions of pollution or nuisance; administrative assessment of civil liability in amounts of up to \$5,000 per day per violation; referral to the State Attorney General for injunctive relief; and referral to the District Attorney for criminal prosecution.

The next monitoring report required to be submitted is the June 2009 monthly monitoring report, which is due by August 1, 2009.



Waste Discharge Requirements: Order No. 2001-352

Facility: Carlsbad Water Recycling Facility

## YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED THAT:

The Carlsbad Municipal Water District (District) is in violation of Order No. 2001-352, Waste Discharge Requirements for the Carlsbad Municipal Water District, Carlsbad Water Recycling Facility, San Diego County. These violations subject the District to possible further enforcement action by the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region (Regional Board), including administrative enforcement orders requiring the District to cease and desist from violations, or to clean up waste and abate existing or threatened conditions of pollution or nuisance; administrative assessment of civil liability in amounts of up to \$5,000 per day per violation<sup>1</sup>; referral to the State Attorney General for injunctive relief; and referral to the District Attorney for criminal prosecution.

The Regional Board reviewed the following monitoring reports which were submitted for Order No. 2001-352.

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A total of 22 effluent violations were indentified in the subject monitoring reports. The violations consisted of the following:

## **Summary of Violations**

- 1. The daily average effluent turbidity values were reported as 2.3 and 2.5 Nephelometric Turbidity Units (NTU) on April 14 and March 25, 2009 respectively. These values exceeded the daily average effluent turbidity limit of 2 NTU specified in Discharge Specification B.2 of Order No. 2001-0352.
- 2. There were 19 violations of Discharge Specification B.5, which states that the daily effluent manganese concentration shall not exceed 0.06 milligrams per Liter (mg/L). The number of daily effluent manganese violations for each month are listed below:

Three violations for March 2009

One violation for December 2008

Two violations for November 2008

Four violations for October 2008

Five violations for September 2008

Four violations for August 2008

3. The effluent residual chlorine concentration was reported as 343 milligrams-minutes per Liter (mg-min/L) on September 23, 2009. A minimum effluent residual chlorine concentration of 450 mg-min/L is required to be maintained at all times.
