YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED THAT:

The County of San Diego (County) violated Order No. 87-108, Waste Discharge Requirements for the County of San Diego, Rancho Del Campo Water Pollution Control Facility, San Diego County. The violations subject the County to possible further enforcement action by the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region (Regional Board), including administrative enforcement orders requiring the County to cease and desist from violations, or to clean up waste and abate existing or threatened conditions of pollution or nuisance; administrative civil liability in amounts of up to \$5,000 per day per violation;² referral to the State Attorney General for injunctive relief; and referral to the District Attorney for criminal prosecution.

The Regional Board reviewed the following quarterly and annual monitoring reports required by Order No. 87-108:

A total of 6 effluent violations were identified in the above reports. The violations consisted of the following:

Summary of Violations

- 1. The daily effluent concentration of biochemical oxygen demand (BOD), which is prescribed at 45 milligrams per liter (mg/L), was exceeded on July 10, 2008 with a reported value of 46 mg/L.
- 2. The sludge disposal log was missing in the 3rd Quarterly (July September) Report 2008, which is required in the Monitoring Report section B of Order No. 01-0123.
- 3. The daily effluent concentration of BOD (45 mg/L) was exceeded on November 24, 2008 with a reported value of 52 mg/L.
- 4. The daily effluent concentration of BOD (45 mg/L) was exceeded on February 19, 2009 with a reported value of 47 mg/L.
- 5. The daily effluent concentration of total suspended solids (45 mg/L) was exceeded on February 19, 2009 with a reported value of 64 mg/L.
- 6. The quarterly effluent results for BOD concentrations were reported as 23.6 mg/L, 50.5 mg/L, 36.0 mg/L, and 35.3 mg/L on January 30, 2009. The average of these four concentrations is 36.4 mg/L. Discharge Specifications B1 of Order No.87-108 states that the annual average effluent BOD concentration shall not exceed 30 mg/L.
