SUBJECT: NON-SUBMITTAL OF 2009 ANNUAL MONITORING REPORT SACRED ROCKS RV PARK

This letter is to inform you that the January-December 2009 annual monitoring report has not been submitted to the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region (San Diego Water Board). Failure to submit the 2009 annual monitoring report is a violation of Order No. 95-34. The annual report is required to be submitted by January 30<sup>th</sup> of every year pursuant to the Monitoring and Reporting Program of Order No. 95-34. Please submit the referenced annual report as soon as possible.

Enclosed is a copy of the annual report template, which should be kept as a copy at the facility and used every year for submittal of your facility's annual monitoring reports. The report is more than 180 days overdue. You will be out of compliance with Order No. 95-34, and will continue to accrue days of violation until the San Diego Water Board receives the annual report.

Failure to submit reports required by Waste Discharge Requirements within 30 days from the due date are considered priority violations and are subject to civil liabilities pursuant to California Water Code Section 13350. Civil liability amounts imposed by the San Diego Water Board under this section range from \$100 to \$5,000 per day per violation, or up to \$10 per gallon for each gallon of waste discharged.
