SUBJECT: REVIEW OF MONITORING REPORTS FOR SEWAGE TREATMENT PLANT 9 (STP #9)

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region (San Diego Water Board) has reviewed the October 2010 monthly monitoring report submitted by the United States Marine Corps (USMC) in accordance with the Monitoring and Reporting Program of Order No. 98-04.

The San Diego Water Board identified the following violation of Prohibition A.1 of Order No. 98-04:

The USMC reported that a spill of 1,000 gallons of tertiary disinfected wastewater occurred from an effluent line near Red Beach on October 8, 2010, which was damaged by Southern California Edison's maintenance crew. The USMC, however, reported that repairs were completed on the damaged effluent line.

The next monitoring report to be submitted is the November 2010 monthly monitoring report due by December 30, 2010.
