

SUBJECT: PRINCE OF PEACE ABBEY

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region (San Diego Water Board) has reviewed the January-December 2009 annual monitoring report submitted by the Prince of Peace Abbey in accordance with Monitoring and Reporting Program No. 86-24.

Wastewater analysis results for sodium and pH were not included in the 2009 annual monitoring report. Non submittal of the referenced results is a violation of Section D.4 (Reporting Requirements) of Order No. 86-24. Section B (Oxidation Pond) of Monitoring and Reporting Program No. 86-24 specifies that wastewater in the oxidation pond shall be analyzed for pH and sodium annually.

Please be aware these violations subject you to possible further enforcement action by the San Diego Water Board, including administrative enforcement orders requiring you to cease and desist from violations, or to clean up waste and abate existing or threatened conditions of pollution or nuisance; administrative assessment of civil liability in amounts of up to \$5,000 per day per violation; referral to the State Attorney General for injunctive relief; and referral to the District Attorney for criminal prosecution

The next monitoring report required to be submitted is the January-December 2010 annual monitoring report, which is due by January 30, 2011.
