SUBJECT: REVIEW OF MONITORING REPORT FOR ORDER NO. R9-2000-0010 SAN ELIJO RECLAMATIONI FACILITY

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region has reviewed the September and October 2010 monthly and the July-September 2010 quarterly monitoring reports submitted by the San Elijo Joint Powers Authority in accordance with Monitoring and Reporting Program No. R9-2000-0010.

The San Diego Water Board identified the following violation of the Discharge Specifications contained in Order No. R9-2000-0010:

The 12-month average Discharge Specification A.1 for total dissolved solids, established at 1,200 milligrams per liter (mg/L), was exceeded for the period of October 2009-September 2010 with a reported value of 1,212 mg/L.

Please be aware this violation subjects you to possible further enforcement action by the San Diego Water Board, including administrative enforcement orders requiring the you to cease and desist from violations, or to clean up waste and abate existing or threatened conditions of pollution or nuisance; administrative assessment of civil liability in amounts of up to \$5,000 per day per violation; 1 referral to the State Attorney General for injunctive relief; and referral to the District Attorney for criminal prosecution.

The next monitoring report to be submitted is the November 2010 monthly monitoring report which is due by December 30, 2010.
