RANCHO DEL CAMPO WATER POLLUTION CONTROL FACILITY


The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region (San Diego Water Board) has reviewed the January-March 2010 and April-June 2010 quarterly monitoring reports submitted by County of San Diego (County in accordance with Monitoring and Reporting Program No. 87-108.

The following violations of Section B.1 (Discharge Specifications) of Order No. 87-108 were identified in the submitted reports:

1. The 12-month average discharge specification for nitrate established at 75 milligrams per liter (mg/L), was exceeded for the 12-month period of April 2009-March 2010 and July 2009-June 2010 with reported values of 113.2 mg/L and 97.9 mg/L, respectively.

Please be aware these violations subject the County to possible further enforcement action by the San Diego Water Board, including administrative enforcement orders requiring the you to cease and desist from violations, or to clean up waste and abate existing or threatened conditions of pollution or nuisance; administrative assessment of civil liability in amounts of up to \$5,000 per day per violation; 1 referral to the State Attorney General for injunctive relief; and referral to the District Attorney for criminal prosecution.
