SUBJECT: RAMONA LANDFILL INSPECTION REPORT

Enclosed is a copy of our June 17, 2011 inspection of the Ramona Landfill. During the inspection, contaminated green waste was observed on the northern sideslope and a small portion of the eastern sideslope. The use of contaminated green waste on the final cover is a violation of Title 27 California Code of Regulations Section 21090(a)(3)(A)(1)a which states that the vegetative layer of the final cover shall not contain waste. Mr. Tom Gardner indicated that the contaminants would be picked out of the contaminated green waste. All of the contamination would need to be removed in order to comply with Title 27.

In addition, the presence of contaminated green waste is also a potential stormwater issue. This is not an acceptable best management practice for the closed landfill.
