SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR MONITORING LOCATION CHANGE, CHOLLAS CREEK TMDL MONITORING PER INVESTIGATIVE ORDER NO. R9-2004-0277

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region (San Diego Water Board) received your letter dated August 30, 2011 requesting a change to the current 38th street and Alpha Street (DPR2) monitoring location required by Investigative Order No. R9-2004-0277. The City of San Diego (City) has proposed to move this existing monitoring location further downstream to Beta Street and Birch Street (Attachment 1). The City indicates that this new location would provide for easier access, improve accuracy of flow monitoring, and improve the precision of flow-weighted composite samples. We reviewed the information provided by the City to support the change and concur with the request. Pursuant to California Water Code Section 13385, Investigative Order No. R9-2004-0277 is amended to replace the DPR2 monitoring location with the new location at Beta Street and Birch Street.


