The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region has reviewed the December 2010 monthly, fourth quarterly 2010, and 2010 annual monitoring reports submitted by the Zoological Society of San Diego in accordance with the Monitoring and Reporting Program of Order No. 99-04.

The following violation of Order No. 99-04 was identified in the submitted report:

1. The daily maximum effluent limitation for chloride of Discharge Specification B.4, established at 400 milligrams per liter (mg/L), was exceeded on December 27, 2010 with a reported value of 1,120 mg/L.
