Reports (SMRs) for Dana Point Shipyard, Order Nos. R9-2006-0019, and R9-

2013-0026, NPDES Permit No. CAG719001

Ms. Cope:

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region (San Diego Water Board) has reviewed the following self-monitoring reports (SMRs) and technical reports submitted between April 2012 and October 2015 for the aforementioned facility:

- Quarterly SMRs April 2012 through December 2015.
- Annual SMRs January 2012 through December 2015.

The following is a summary of the San Diego Water Board's findings:

- Violation Missing Reports, Attachment E Section VII.B.3.
 - 1. Quarterly SMRs are due for the first quarter (January–March) by May 1, for the second quarter (April–June) by August 1, for the third quarter (July–September) by November 1, and for the fourth quarter (October–December) by February 1 of each year. The following quarterly reports were not submitted:
 - a. Second quarterly report for 2012;
 - 2. Annual report containing Annual Compliance Certification, Spill/Illicit Discharge Log, Annual Storm Water Report, and Submergence Report and Ballast Tank Certification is due August 1 of each year. The following annual reports have not been submitted:
 - a. Annual Reports for 2012 and 2014.

Pursuant to the California Water Code (CWC), the violations noted may be subject to additional enforcement action(s) by the San Diego Water Board including a time schedule order, cease and desist order, cleanup and abatement order, imposition of administrative civil liability, referral to the district attorney for criminal prosecution, or referral to the attorney general. Administrative civil liability amounts that may be imposed by the Regional Board under authority of CWC Section 13385 include up to \$10,000 per day, or up to \$10 per gallon for each gallon of waste discharged.
