SUPPLEMENTAL NOTICE OF PRE-HEARING CONFERENCE FOR Tentative Cleanup and Abatement Order No. R9-2005-0126

The purpose of this Notice is to supplement the August 29, 2005 Notice for the Pre-hearing Conference scheduled for September 26, 2005. The August 29 Notice, distributed to interested persons and the recommended designated parties, contains the recommendation of the Advisory Team of the Regional Board to the Presiding Officer to name ten entities as designated parties. This supplemental notice recommends that the Shipyard Sediment Site Cleanup Team of the Regional Board to the list of designated parties.

BACKGROUND

The staff of the San Diego Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Water Board) has issued Tentative Cleanup and Abatement Order No. R9-2005-0126, which establishes proposed cleanup requirements for San Diego Bay marine sediments located within and adjacent to the NASSCO and BAE Systems San Diego Ship Repair (formerly Southwest Marine) shipyard leaseholds.

DESIGNATED PARTIES FOR THE HEARING

Participants at a hearing are either "designated parties" or "interested persons." Parties to the hearing may present evidentiary testimony and are subject to cross-examination. Parties may also cross-examine other parties' witnesses. Interested persons may present non-evidentiary policy statements, but may not present evidentiary testimony. Interested persons are not subject to cross-examination and may not cross-examine parties.
