# Directives

- Tentative CAO R9-2005-0126
- Directives A through G
  - Cleanup and Abatement
  - Remedial Action Plan
  - Post Cleanup Monitoring

# Directive A – Cleanup and Abate

- The dischargers shall take corrective actions necessary to cleanup contaminated marine sediment at shipyard sites to the clean up levels specified.

# Directive B - Remedial Action Plan

- The dischargers shall submit a Remedial Action Plan
  - Implementation activities
  - Shipyard sediment site maps
  - Schedule
  - Short term effectiveness monitoring activities
- Responsible parties will draft RAP

# Directive B - Remedial Action Plan Implementation

- Remedial Action Plan implementation
  - Notify Regional Board
  - Comply with condition set by the Regional Board

# Directive D – Post Cleanup Monitoring

- The dischargers shall submit a post cleanup monitoring plan
- The dischargers shall submit annual post cleanup monitoring progress reports and a final post cleanup monitoring report
